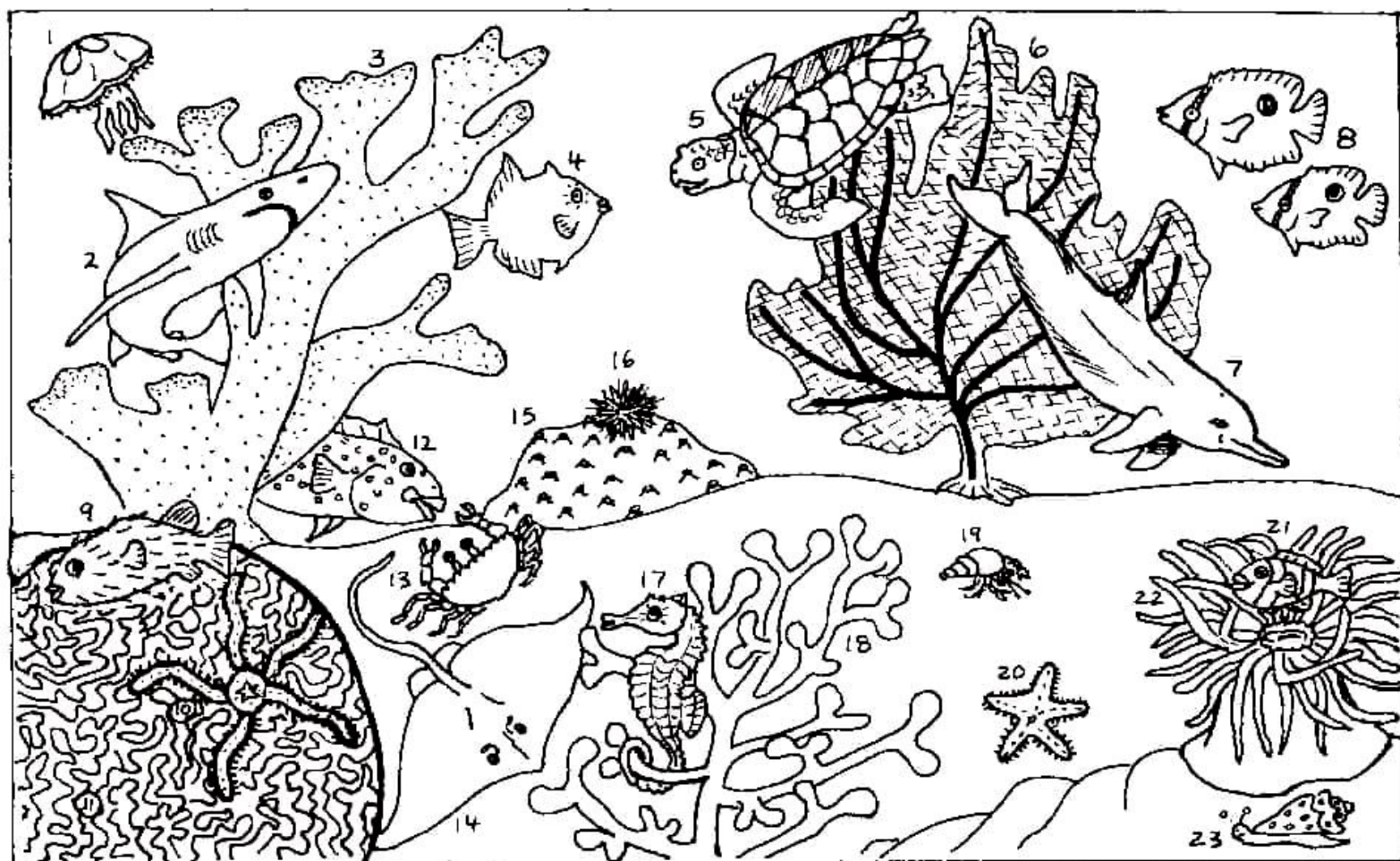
Coral Reef

Coral reefs are warm, clear, shallow ocean habitats that are rich in life. A reef's massive structure is formed from coral polyps, tiny animals that live in colonies; when coral polyps die, they leave behind a hard, stony, branching structure made of limestone. The coral provides shelter for many animals in this complex habitat.

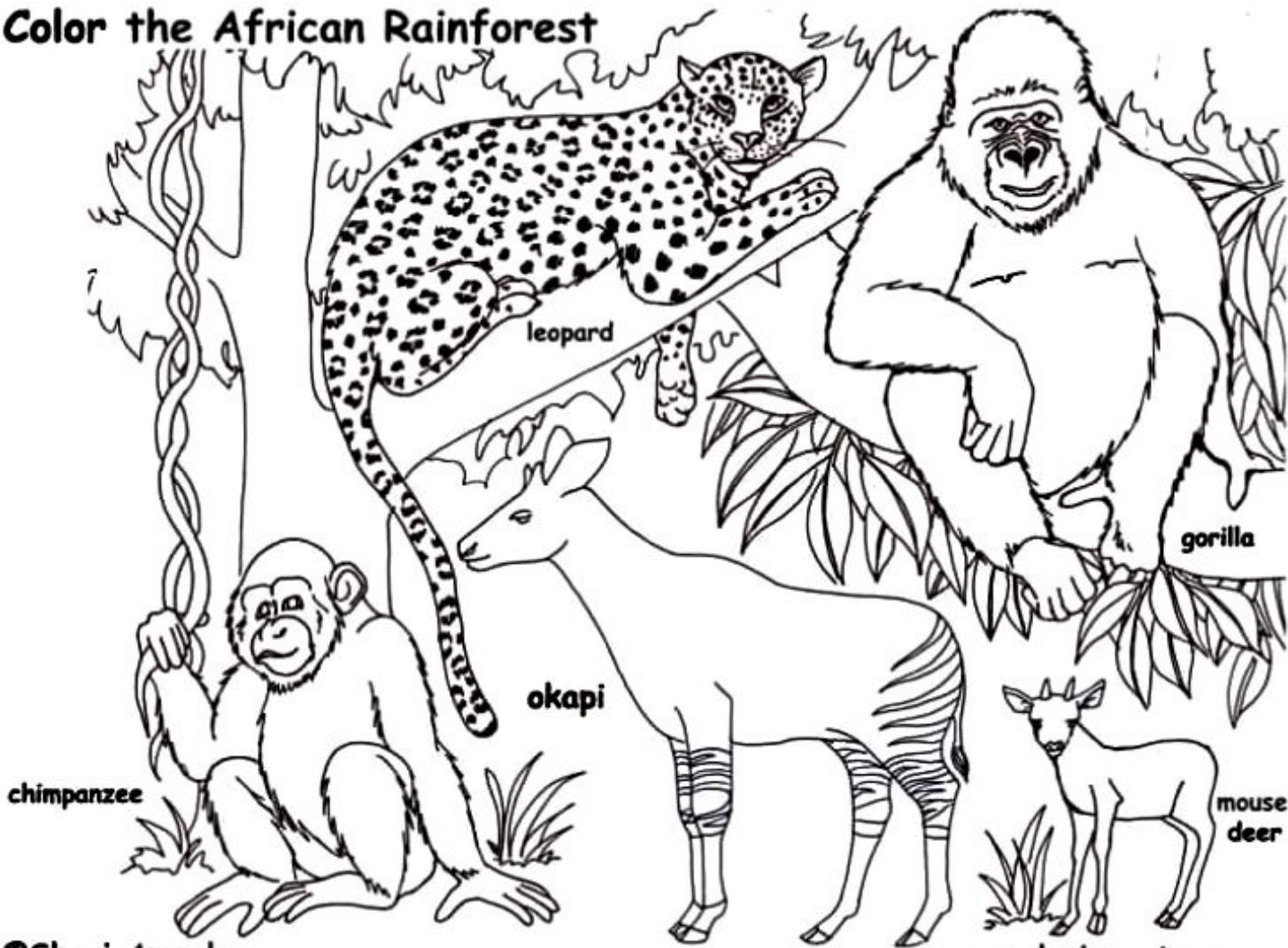


All About Freshwater

Lakes, rivers, rivers, and streams are freshwater habitats, as are swamps, bays, and marshes. Together these ecosystems contain all the water in the world that is abundant, salt-free, and accessible to humans. Freshwater habitats account for less than half a percent of the world's water supply but they are vital to the survival of humans and a wide range of animals, from amphibians and plants to humans and buildings. They contain many species, amphibians, invertebrates (such as freshwater clams), and birds, offering them a place to breed, feed, and find refuge.

Rainforest Structure Diagram



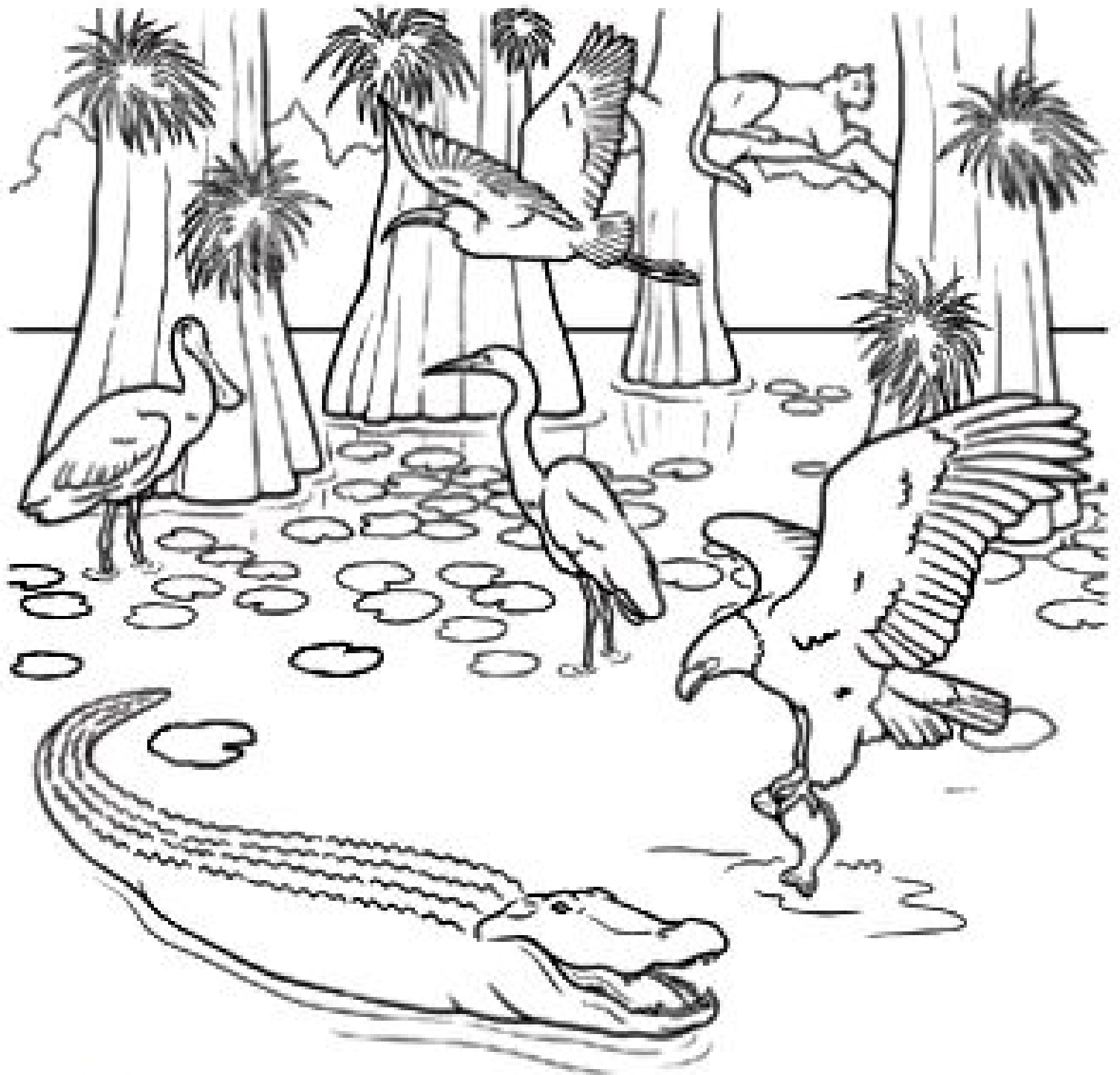
